Submission Guidelines:

The awards program eligibility criteria require participants to comply with all guidelines as stipulated below:

- The entrant must be employed at any private or public school in the Asia-Pacific Region.
- The entrant for Emerging Educator of the Year must have one to three years of teaching experience.
- The entrant for the Outstanding Teacher and the Asia-Pacific Top Educator Awardee categories must have at least five years of teaching experience.
- The entrant for the Outstanding Master Teacher and Principal categories must hold the position for at least one year.
- Entrants are permitted to submit a maximum of two distinct and eligible entries in separate categories. Each entry must satisfy all requirements of a category in order for it to be considered accepted.

- Entries must be submitted as a **.pdf file** using the Asia-Pacific Top Educator Awards Nomination Form. File names must conform to this format: EntrantFirstName_EentrantLastName_Award Category Name.pdf
- Entries Asia-Pacific Top Educator Awards and its Organizer the right to disclose their submissions to judges for evaluation.
- Entries submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.
- Attend and participate in the Awards Night.

In addition, it is mandatory for the entrant to follow the additional rules and regulations, upon dealing with general entry rules and regulations. For each entry, the participant shall:

- Independently create his/her submission.
- Explain the reason of the nomination in 500-word strategy statement.
- Submit attachments or links that can support or serves as proof for the strategy statement.
- Merge the strategy statement, attachment, and/or link to form a **single .pdf** file within five pages or less of material.
- Save the file with this file name format: EntrantFirstName_EentrantLastName_Award Category Name.pdf
